

2023 membership survey summary


The principal aim of this membership survey was to look at playing bridge from September 2023. Are the members happy with the current arrangements or do we need to change them?

Fifty-three responses, out of 94 members, were received.




The final question of the survey shows that there is some desire to play more than we currently do.







The following chart reflects the views of the people who play online and at the Parish Centre.



16 of the 18 members who wanted a second day expressed an opinion on when.




There was less enthusiasm for a second BBO session in the week.
