#### AGM

This would have two advantages: it would allow the accounts to be drawn up for the full playing season (including the congress). At present the last few sessions and the congress are carried over into the following year's accounts, Secondly, competitions would be completed and results known which would allow trophies to be engraved prior to their presentation at the meeting.

We will need to check the constitution to see if this proposal should be included on the agenda for this year's AGM.

(Subsequently it was decided that a motion is not required at the AGM although the topic will be covered by the President)

## **General Data Protection Regulation**
