This information will be recorded in our membership database, which is stored online in compliance with the GDPR. Our membership data is shared with the Scottish Bridge Union, the governing body of the game of duplicate bridge.

A limited amount of your information (name, SBU number, post town) will be listed in the SBU's database made available for use by scoring program providers and users. This is to allow the correct identification of players for scoring purposes.

Your data may be processed by Pianola/Bridgewebs/other organisations that act as Data Processors on our behalf. They may only use it for the specific purposes for which they act as our data processors and they are not free to pass this on to other organisations.

Your personal data is not passed on by us for use by any other third parties whether or not connected with bridge.
