GENERAL DESCRIPTION OF SYSTEM

Bidding Methods:- 4-card majors, 12-14 1NT
Strong 2♣
Three weak twos 2♦/2♥/2♠

Style of leads, signals, discards:- 4th highest leads, 2nd from bad suit
High=encouraging, high-low=even
Low=enc vs suits, suit pref vs NT

STRENGTH OF 1NT OPENERS: 12-14

2♣ RESPONSE TO 1NT OPENER IS: Non-promissory Stayman

Both players of a partnership must have identically completed convention cards.
Cards must be exchanged with opponents for each round.
